



OAK SPRING EARLY CAREER FELLOWSHIP

THE STACY LLOYD III FELLOWSHIP FOR BIBLIOGRAPHIC STUDY

In 2018, the Oak Spring Garden Foundation will award one Stacy Lloyd III Fellowship for Bibliographic Study of \$10,000 for a two-month fellowship. The aim of the program is to support an outstanding early-career scholar who wishes to use the Oak Spring Garden Library collection in his/her bibliographic research in some area related to plants, gardens and landscapes, and who can articulate the likely contributions of the Oak Spring Garden Library collections to the fulfillment of his/her research objectives. The fellowship will be a two-month long fellowship, with at least two weeks, and up to two months of that time being spent working on-site at Oak Spring.

Eligibility

✿ Available to an early-career scholar who is a U.S. citizen or permanent resident. Applicants must also be a current candidate for a post-graduate degree and currently engaged in research that would be facilitated by access to the Oak Spring Garden Library collection. The selected awardee must be available to spend at least two weeks before the end of 2018 at the Oak Spring estate in Upperville, Virginia.

Application Process

✿ To begin your application, complete the [Lloyd III Fellowship Eligibility Questionnaire here](#). If you are eligible, you will be prompted to register for the OSGF Applicant Portal, where you will complete your application. You will be prompted to submit:

- i) a resume/curriculum vitae,
- ii) a short description of your interest in the Oak Spring Estate and/or Oak Spring Garden Library and what you hope to gain from the experience,
- iii) any and all relevant links/uploads to/of writing samples/research outputs, and
- iv) a travel budget of up to \$1,000 for travel to/from the Oak Spring Estate.

Applicants are expected to show exceptional promise, excellence in research, and good communication skills.

Selection Process

✿ The awardee will be selected by a panel of three distinguished administrators, scholars, or practitioners with experience and/or knowledge in the field.

Other Information

✿ Travel arrangements of up to \$1,000 will be funded on a reimbursement basis. Accommodations (including boarding and meals) will be provided on-site for a minimum of 14 days and up to two months.
